Pencils, eraser & pencil sharpener, 1 box of colored markers, 1 box of colored pencils, 1 box of crayons, scissors, glue sticks, ruler, pencil box, dictionary, 3-ring binder, 2 folders

GRADES 4th - 8th

Pencils, eraser & pencil sharpener, pens (black, blue, and 2 red), ruler, highlighters (1 yellow, 1 other color), 1 box of colored pencils, zipper pouch, spiral notebooks (3), paperback dictionary & thesaurus (optional), 3-ring binder, binder paper (college ruled), simple business calculator, 2 or 3 Pee Chee type folders, 2 glue sticks
